Tyres and rims (Existing series) for agricultural tractors and machines — Part 4 : Tyre classification and nomenclature

1 Scope and field of application

This International Standard sets out the classification codes and nomenclature of existing series of tyres for agricultural tractors and machines.

Tyre designation and dimensions, load ratings, and rim dimensions are given in ISO 4251/1, ISO 4251/2, and ISO 4251/3 respectively.

2 Tyre classification and type nomenclature

Nomenclature and classification code markings are given in the table.

The classification code is not part of the size marking and its use is optional. When used, the code shall be clearly separated from the size markings on the tyres.
