Add the following:

# 3.101 **duct fan**

fan for installation within an enclosed airway so that the airflow is ducted on both the inlet and outlet sides

# 5 General conditions for the tests

#### **5.7** Add the following:

For fans marked with an ambient operating temperature, the tests of Clauses 10, 11 and 13 are carried out at the marked value  $\pm$  2 °C.

# 7 Marking and instructions

### 7.1 Add the following:

Fans intended for operation in locations where the local ambient temperature exceeds 40  $^{\circ}\text{C}$  shall be marked with the ambient operating temperature.
