7.1 Addition:

Replace the last paragraph of the addition by the following:

If the temperature rises determined during the tests of Clause 19 exceed the limits specified in Clause 11, appliances shall be marked with symbol IEC 60417-5641 (DB:2002-10) combined with the prohibition sign of ISO 3864-1, except for colours, or with the substance of the following:

WARNING: Do not cover.

NOTE 101 This marking may be on a label that is permanently attached to the appliance.

7.6 Replace the existing text by the following:

Add the following symbol:



Do not cover

NOTE This symbol incorporates symbol IEC 60417-5641(DB:2002-10) combined with the prohibition sign of ISO 3864-1, except for colours.

7.10 Add the following sentence to the addition.

However, disconnection of the neutral pole is not required for single phase appliances permanently connected to a system with an earthed neutral (TN-S-C system).
