INTRODUCTION

A series of parts of IEC 61857 is being developed, each of which will address a specific test object and/or application with an associated test procedure.

This part of IEC 61857 provides a general purpose procedure for the evaluation of wire-wound systems using a general purpose encapsulated model (ECM) where the application is unknown.

As a function of the horizontal committee concept, additional parts will be developed in cooperation with IEC technical committees responsible for equipment.
