Foreword

A proposal to amend EN 50088:1996 was discussed during the Balsthal meeting of CENELEC TC 61 in June 2004 when it was decided to delay the “dow” for the laser part of EN 50088:1996/A3:2002, Annex I.

During the Milan meeting in November 2004, it was decided instead to delete Annex I because its content is covered by the new EN 62115:2005, which is replacing EN 50088 and its amendments.

The draft amendment, prepared by the Technical Committee CENELEC TC 61, was submitted to the formal vote in May 2005 and was approved by CENELEC as amendment A4 to EN 50088:1996 on 2005-11-01.

The following dates are applicable:

- latest date by which the amendment has to be implemented
at national level by publication of an identical
national standard or by endorsement (dop) 2006-05-01
- date on which national standards conflicting
with the amendment have to be withdrawn (dow) 2006-05-01

This amendment supplements or modifies the corresponding clauses of EN 50088:1996.
