The proposal to endorse the third edition of IEC Publication 335-2-4, document CENELEC/TC 61 (SEC) 442, was circulated under the enquiry procedure in March 1985.

This proposal was discussed during the Zandvoort meeting in June 1986 when it was decided to submit a draft for EN 60 335-2-4 to the voting procedure. This procedure started in March 1988.

The text of this draft was ratified by the CENELEC Technical Board on the 13th of September 1988.

For spin extractors incorporated in appliances having a single container for washing and water extraction the peripheral speed of which does not exceed 40 m/s and the motive energy of which does not exceed 1500 J, the appliance shall be provided with an automatic means for switching off the motor, or for reducing the container speed to normal washing speed or less within 5 s after the lid or door is opened by 50 mm.

For spin extractors incorporated in appliances having a single container for washing and water extraction the peripheral speed of which exceeds 40 m/s or the motive energy of which exceeds 1500 J, the appliance shall be provided with a means for preventing the opening of the lid or door while the container is in motion at a speed exceeding 60 revolutions per minute.

### 1. NATIONAL DEVIATIONS DUE TO LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

20 SWEDEN (National Swedish Board for Consumer Policies, Law of Marketing, Clause 4, and STEV-FS 1988:1, Clause 41)

Lids and doors shall be interlocked in such a way that the appliance can only be operated when the lid or door is closed, and that the lid or door cannot be opened while the container is in motion.

UNITED KINGDOM (Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Act 1963, ITeh STA Chapter 41, Section 17(1); Factories Act 1961, Chapter 34, Section 14(1); Health and Safety at (Stanwork, Cetc. 1974, Chapter 37, Section 2 and Section 4)

Spin extractors intended for communal use in blocks of flats or in laundrettes shall without exception, be interlocked in such a way that the appliance can only be operated when the lids or doors are closed, and that lids or doors cannot be opened while the container is in motion.
