### INTRODUCTION

Replace the second sentence of the second paragraph by the following:

It also covers abnormal situations that can be expected in practice and takes into account the way in which electromagnetic phenomena can affect the safe operation of appliances.

Replace the fifth paragraph by the following:

When a part 2 standard does not include additional requirements to cover hazards dealt with in Part 1, Part 1 applies.

NOTE 1 This means that the technical committees responsible for the part 2 standards have determined that it is not necessary to specify particular requirements for the appliance in question over and above the general requirements.

This standard is a product family standard dealing with the safety of appliances and takes precedence over horizontal and generic standards covering the same subject.

NOTE 2 Horizontal and generic standards covering a hazard are not applicable since they have been taken into consideration when developing the general and particular requirements for the IEC 60335 series of standards. For example, in the case of temperature requirements for surfaces on many appliances, generic standards, such as ISO 13732-1 for hot surfaces, are not applicable in addition to Part 1 or part 2 standards.

## 1 Scope

Add the following to Note 101 as a new second dashed item.

water filled foot massagers;

Replace the two dashed items in the fourth paragraph by the following:

- persons (including children) whose
  - physical, sensory or mental capabilities; or
  - lack of experience and knowledge
  - prevents them from using the appliance safely without supervision or instruction;
- children playing with the appliance.

## 3 Definitions

**3.1.9** Add the following:

Foot massage appliances that use water are filled with water at a temperature of 40  $^\circ\text{C}$  ± 2  $^\circ\text{C}.$ 

# 7 Marking and instructions TANDARD PREVIEW

7.12 Add the following:

The instructions for appliances having a liquid container that is filled with water shall include the substance of the following. b44d1e841c6c/sist-en-60335-2-32-2003/A1-2009

If water leaks from the appliance, the appliance should no longer be used.

## 11 Heating

**11.8** Add the following:

The water temperature at the middle of the water volume shall not exceed 50 °C.

### **15 Moisture resistance**

Replace the text by the following:

This clause of Part 1 is applicable except as follows.

**15.2** Addition:

Water filled foot massagers are completely filled with water containing approximately 1 % NaCl and are then emptied within 30 s by being tilted or overturned in the most unfavourable way.

### 21 Mechanical strength

Replace "Addition:" by "21.1 Addition:".

## 22 Construction

Add the following new subclause:

**22.102** Appliances that use water and in which air is circulated shall be constructed so that the water cannot penetrate into the motor and come into contact with **live parts** or **basic insulation**.

Compliance is checked by the following test.

The overflow outlet is blocked and the appliance is filled until water overflows. Non-return valves are rendered inoperative one at a time.

After the test, there shall be no trace of water on insulation that could result in a reduction of **clearances** or **creepage distances** below the values specified in Clause 29.
