Text of A11 to EN 61029-1:2009

18 Stability and mechanical hazards

18.1 **Add** after the 3rd paragraph:

For fixed guards that are to be removed at the place of use as part of the routine maintenance procedure, as described in the instruction manual, the fastenings shall remain attached to the guard or to the tool.

NOTE 1 Replacement of brushes is not considered as part of the routine maintenance.

Replace the existing 'NOTE' by 'NOTE 2'.
