### **Foreword**

This document (EN 71-1:2005/prA1:2005) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 52 "Safety of toys", the secretariat of which is held by DS.

This document is currently submitted to the CEN Enquiry.

This document has been prepared under a mandate given to CEN by the European Commission and the European Free Trade Association, and supports essential requirements of EU Directive(s).

Amend heading and add a new 2nd paragraph to 4.19, which will then read as follows:

## 4.19 Percussion caps specifically designed for use in toys <u>and toys using percussion caps</u> (see A.24)

Assuming reasonably foreseeable use, percussions caps specifically designed for use in toys shall not produce debris which could cause eye injuries, flames or glowing residues.

Toys intended to be used with percussion caps shall carry an indication regarding which percussion caps they can be safely used with, and a warning that use of other caps may cause damage to hearing (see 7.14).

The packaging of percussion caps shall carry a warning (see 7.13).

Amend 7.14 which will then read as follows:

#### 7.14 Acoustics (see 4.20 f))

Toys which produce high impulse sound levels, or their packaging shall carry a warning:

"Warning! Do not use close to the ear! Misuse may cause damage to hearing."

For toys using percussion caps, add adjacent to the text above:

"Do not fire indoors! Use only percussion caps recommended by the manufacturer"

Amend heading of A.24, which will then read as follows:

# A.24 Percussion caps specifically designed for use in toys <u>and toys using</u> <u>percussion caps</u> (see 4.19)
