2 Definitions

Add, on page 15, the following new definition:

2.2.110 **pan detector**: A device incorporated in a **hob element**, which prevents its operation unless a vessel is placed on the **cooking_zone**.

NOTE - A pan detector is not considered to be a thermostat or protective device.

Page 17

7 Marking and instructions

7.12 Add, on page 19, the following to the addition:

The instructions for use for hobs with hob elements incoporating pan detectors shall include the substance of the following.

After use, switch the **hob element** off by means of its control. Do not rely on the **pan detector**.

7.12.4 Add, on page 21, the following to the addition:

The instructions for **built-in appliances** having a separate control panel for several appliances shall state that the control panel is only to be connected to the specified appliances in order to avoid a possible hazard.

Add the following text:

19.2 Addition:

Pan detectors are rendered inoperative.
