Introduction

PVC-C Type I piping systems for low-temperature heating applications have been used successfully in some countries for more than 30 years. Therefore, this amendment proposes to add into ISO 15877 Class 4 as defined in ISO 10508, for the conditions of service used in these countries (4 and 6 bars).
