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BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 245, *Aircraft Lockwire*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 20, *Aircraft*, the Secretariat of which is held by the British Standards Institution (B.S.I.).

Work on this question by the Technical Commmitte began in 1958 and led, in 1959, to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In August 1960, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 400) was submitted to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved, subject to some editorial amendments, by the following Member Bodies:

One Member Body opposed the approval of the Draft: Germany.

The Draft ISO Recommendation was then submitted by correspondence to the ISO Council, which decided, in February 1962, to accept it as an ISO RECOMMENDATION.

AIRCRAFT LOCKWIRE

1. Aircraft lockwire should be made from one of the materials listed in Table 1.

2. The dimensions of the range of lockwires and the holes for which they are suitable are given in Table 2.

3. At room temperature the finished wire should withstand, without breaking or cracking, bending through 180° and return, nine times over a mandrel of the relevant diameter quoted in Table 3.
