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ISO/IEC 26300 was prepared by the OASIS OpenDocument Technical Committee [as OASIS Open Document Format for Office Applications (OpenDocument) v1.0 (second edition)] and was adopted, under the PAS procedure, by Joint Technical Committee ISO/IEC JTC 1, *Information technology*, in parallel with its approval by the national bodies of ISO and IEC. The content of ISO/IEC 26300 and OASIS OpenDocument v1.0 2nd ed. is identical.

This is the specification of the Open Document Format for Office Applications (OpenDocument) format, an open, XML-based file format for office applications, based on OpenOffice.org XML [OOo].
