FOREWORD

Prior to 1972, the results of the work of the Technical Committees were published VIEW as ISO Recommendations; these documents are now in the process of being transformed into International Standards. As part of this process, Technical Committee ISO/TC 6 has reviewed ISO Recommendation R 415 and found it technically suitable for transformation. 
1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard lays down the area on envelopes, postcards and similar articles, which is to be reserved for affixing the postage stamp(s) and applying the cancellation mark used by postal administrations.

2 SPECIFICATIONS

On envelopes, postcards and similar articles the cancelling and despatch of which are entrusted to the postal services, an area shall be reserved where the postage stamp(s) can be affixed and the cancellation mark can appear; this shall be at the top right-hand corner of the face bearing the addressee's address (recto according to postal terminology).

This area shall have the following characteristics :



NOTE – In principle, the cancellation mark obtained by a cancelling machine is composed of a date stamp and an obliteration mark reproducing one of the following :

wavy lines;

advertising wording;

advertising pattern accompanied by a succinct text.
