	Function To prohibit people riding surfboards in designated swimming areas

Hazard

Harming of people being hit by surfboards in swimming areas

Human behaviour that is intended to be caused after understanding the safety sign's meaning

Surfboard riders surfing outside swimming areas

Human behaviour that is intended to be prevented

Surfboard riders surfing in swimming areas

Need

People can be injured if surfboards enter a designated swimming area

Context of use

In areas of aquatic activities where swimming areas and surfing may conflict, water safety, aquatic safety

Additional information

It is essential for the flags to be shown in this particular safety sign in the colours they are always used on the beach to ensure understanding of the safety message and avoid confusion with other flags. In these exceptional circumstances, the red and yellow colours of this element of the graphical symbol are shown, in addition to the normal contrast colour of black.

Test data obtained according to ISO 9186-1 is available from more than one country. Findings from testing showed that the graphical symbol exceeded the criteria of acceptability. A supplementary text sign may be used to increase comprehension. If the safety sign is supplemented by manuals, instructions or training, a supplementary text sign may not be required.
