FOREWORD

1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard specifies a supplementary range 93:19 The untrimmed sizes of sheets shall be: of untrimmed stock sizes for paper in reels or sheets which dards/si is to be trimmed to the ISO-A Series of sizes given in 5c/iso-593SRAQ: 90 cm X 128 cm ISO/R 216.

This supplementary range is for use where the primary range specified in ISO 478 is not suitable for certain complex conversion operations and certain special uses.

3 WIDTH OF REELS

The width of reels shall be 45, 64, 90 or 128 cm.

4 UNTRIMMED SIZES OF SHEETS

SRA1: 64 cm × 90 cm

SRA2: 45 cm X 64 cm

5 TOLERANCES

The tolerances shall be in accordance with ISO/R 479.

The permissible deviations on the dimensions given in clauses 3 and 4 shall be:

± 0,5 %, rounded to the nearest millimetre;

nevertheless,

- if 0,5 % is greater than 0,5 cm, the maximum tolerance shall be limited to ± 0,5 cm;
- if 0.5% is less than 0.3 cm, a tolerance of ± 0.3 cm shall be accepted.
