
Add public information symbol PI PF 043 to the alphabetical summary in Table 1, the summary of all symbols in Table 2 and Table 3 as follows:

	<p><b>Reference No.</b> ISO 7001 - PI PF 043</p>
	<p><b>Referent</b> Dentist</p>
	<p><b>Function</b> To indicate the location of a clinical facility for the treatment of teeth and gums.</p>
	<p><b>Image content</b> A tooth viewed from the side. A cross in the upper right corner.</p>
<p><b>Human behaviour that is intended to be caused after understanding the public information symbol's meaning</b> Finding the location of a surgery for clinical treatment of teeth and gums.</p>	
<p><b>Need</b> When information is needed about the location of a surgery for clinical treatment of teeth and gums.</p>	
<p><b>Related meanings</b> -</p>	
<p><b>Field of application</b> Public facilities.</p>	
<p><b>Context of use</b> This information appears on information-boards or in guide-books, on a sign or door.</p>	
<p><b>Intended user population</b> General population.</p>	
<p><b>Age of user</b> Any.</p>	
<p><b>Additional information</b> Test data obtained according to ISO 9186-1:2007 are not available from more than one country. Findings from national testing, however, showed that in one country the symbol exceeded the criteria of acceptability. It is recommended that this symbol is accompanied by text to increase comprehension.  The cross may be replaced with another element appropriate to the cultural requirements of the target group.</p>
