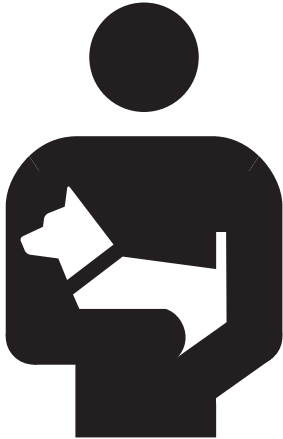

Human behaviour that is intended to be caused after understanding the public information symbol's meaning

To indicate places such as escalators and moving walkways where people with dogs should carry them.

Need

It is not appropriate for dogs to be standing or walking in certain areas such as escalators.

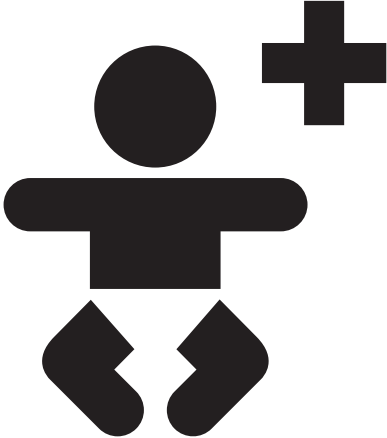
