Foreword

This European Standard has been prepared by the Technical Committee CEN/TC 161 'Foot and leg protectors', the secretariat of which is held by BSI.

This European Standard shall be given the status of a national standard, either by publication of an identical text or by endorsement, at the latest by January 1997, and conflicting national standards shall be withdrawn at the latest by January 1997.

This European Standard has been prepared under a mandate given to CEN by the European Commission and the European Free Trade Association, and supports essential requirements of EU Directive(s).

This European Standard was originally submitted to the CEN enquiry as prEN 192. A modification to the number of the draft was required by CEN/TC 161 and consequently this European Standard is being issued as EN 346-2. Subsequent to the issue of EN 346-2, EN 346:1992 will be renumbered as EN 346-1 in order to maintain clarity in the identifier for EN 346. A similar situation exists for EN 344, EN 345 and EN 347.

0 Introduction

This standard extends the scope of EN 346 by specifying further properties which may be needed in protective footwear for professional use. It cross-refers to EN 346:1992¹ for the basic requirements which are mandatory for all items of protective footwear and, if desired, allows other combinations of properties to be specified by the selection of appropriate optional requirements from table 3 of EN 346:1992¹⁾.

1 Scope

This European Standard specifies, by reference to EN 344:1992¹⁾ and EN 344-2, additional requirements for protective footwear, relating to water resistance, metatarsal protection and cut resistance.

Basic and further optional requirements for protective footwear are given in EN 346:19921).

2 Normative references

This European Standard incorporates by dated or undated references, provisions from other publications. These normative references are cited at the appropriate places in the text and the publications are listed hereafter. For dated references, subsequent amendments to or revisions of any of these publications apply to this European Standard only when incorporated in it by amendment or revision. For undated references the latest edition of the publication referred to applies.

Footwear shall be classified in accordance with table 1 of EN 346:1992.

5 Protective footwear with resistance to water

5.1 Performance

Footwear shall comply with the basic requirements specified in table 2 of EN 346:1992 and with the requirement given in table 1.
