Foreword

This Amendment EN 470-1:1995/A1:1998 to EN 470-1:1995 has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 162 "Protective clothing including hand and arm protection and lifejackets", the secretariat of which is held by DIN.

This Amendment to the European Standard EN 470-1:1995 shall be given the status of a national standard, either by publication of an identical text or by endorsement, at the latest by August 1998, and conflicting national standards shall be withdrawn at the latest by August 1998.

This Amendment to the European Standard EN 470-1:1995 has been prepared under a mandate given to CEN by the European Commission and the European Free Trade Association, and supports essential requirements of EU Directive(s).

According to the CEN/CENELEC Internal Regulations, the national standards organizations of the following countries are bound to implement this European Standard: Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and the United Kingdom.

Subclause 4.3

Delete subclause 4.3 and substitute:

4.3 Pockets

Where protective garments are constructed with pockets, the pockets shall be constructed to the following designs:

- a) all pockets with external openings shall be made of material(s) conforming to 6.1 and 6.2;
- b) external opening pockets shall be flapped except for:
 - side pockets below the waist which do not extend more than 10 ° forward of the side seams;
 - a single rule pocket placed behind the side seams on either or both legs, with an opening no greater than 75 mm measured flat.
- c) all flaps shall be stitched down or capable of fastening the pocket closed. They shall be 20 mm wider than the opening to prevent the flap from being tucked into the pocket.
