This amendment A1 modifies the European Standard EN 60335-2-25:1995; it was approved by CENELEC on 1997-03-11. The proposal to endorse amendment 1:1995 to IEC 335-2-25:1993, document CLC/TC 61 (SEC) 1023, was circulated under the enquiry procedure in June 1995. This proposal was discussed during the Copenhagen meeting in May 1996, when it was decided to submit a draft for an amendment to EN 60335-2-25 to the formal vote.

This draft was circulated in September 1996 and was ratified by CENELEC as amendment A1 on 1997-03-11.

This amendment has been prepared by the secretariat of CENELEC Technical Committee TC 61.

FOREWORD

Change the second sentence in the second paragraph after the document table as follows:

It was established on the basis of the second edition (1976) of that publication, as modified by Amendments No. 1 (1977), No. 2 (1979), No. 3 (1982), No. 4 (1984), No. 5 (1986) and No. 6 (1988).

2 Definitions

Add:

2.2.114 rated microwave power output: Microwave power output assigned to the oven by the manufacturer.

7 Marking

7.12 *Replace the second paragraph of the addition by:*

The instruction sheet shall warn the user that it is hazardous for anyone, other than a qualified service technician, to carry out any service or repair operation which involves removal of any cover which gives protection against exposure to microwave energy.

The instruction sheet shall warn the user that the contents of feeding bottles and baby food jars are to be stirred or shaken and that the temperature is to be checked before consumption, to avoid burns.
