AMENDMENT 193: Safety sign M052: Keep distance between toboggans

	Function To signify that a distance must be kept between toboggans
	Image content Two seated human figures, two toboggans above a sloping line, double-ended arrow between the toboggans
Hazard Toboggan colliding with other toboggans Human behaviour that is intended to be caused after understanding the safety sign's meaning Ensuring enough space to other toboggans in order to stop the toboggan in dangerous situations without colliding with other toboggans Related referents --- Additional information Test data according to ISO 9186-1:2014 are not available. Consequently, a supplementary text sign shall be used to increase comprehension except when the safety sign is supplemented by manuals, instructions or training.
