FOREWORD

1 General

1.1 Scope and object

The purpose of this part of IEC 1300 is to reveal mechanical weakness and/or degradation of fibre optic devices when subjected to repetitive shocks. It simulates repetitive shocks likely to be encountered by the devices during normal service.

1.2 General description

This procedure is conducted in accordance with IEC 68-2-29, test Eb. The specimen is fastened to the table of a bump tester and is subjected to repeated half-sine pulses.

1.3 Normative reference

The following normative document contains provisions which, through reference in this text, constitute provisions of this part of IEC 1300. At the time of publication, the edition indicated was valid. All normative documents are subject to revision, and parties to agreements based on this part of IEC 1300 are encouraged to investigate the possibility of applying the most recent edition of the normative document indicated below.
