Introduction

Incontinence is defined as the complaint of any involuntary leakage of urine and/or faeces. It is estimated that 400 million people are affected by incontinence worldwide, and the number is increasing as the population in many countries ages. Incontinence that cannot be (fully) cured is most commonly managed using absorbent products.

Products come in a range of different designs, but the terms used to describe them vary considerably among - and even within – countries, resulting in a confusing variety of synonyms among clinicians and academics, and in the literature provided by product suppliers. Standardised terminology would facilitate understanding and communication among stakeholders.
