Scope and field of application tandards.ited which normally protects them during storage. Nevertheless, they should not be kept in stock longer than is the contents will not be subject to mechanical damage or sunlight. As soon as any condom shows deterioration (for example tackiness, brittleness) of the rubber, it should be destroyed.

> The condom should not be allowed to come into contact with oil-based antiseptic, phenols and their derivates, petroleumbased grease, petroleum spirit, kerosine and other related organic products.
