Introduction

Gas burning appliances using fuel gases must withstand the type of gas which is specified. Other International Standards cover the testing and properties of fuel gases, e.g. ISO 6976 and ISO 13443.

Due to the differing properties of fuel gas, depending on its source and region of origin, certain differences in regulations exist at present in different regions; some of these differences are presented in <u>Annexes A</u> and <u>E</u>.

This document is supplemented by the corresponding clauses of ISO 21364-21 and ISO 21364-22.

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
