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## Introduction

The purpose of this document is to reduce the risk of death and injury when using baby walking frames. It is stressed that this document cannot eliminate all possible risks to children using such a product and that carer control is of paramount importance.

Conformity to the requirements of this document will minimize potential hazards associated with using baby walking frames.

This document is largely based on the existing European standard EN 1273:2020+A1:2023. The differences between EN 1273:2020+A1:2023 and this document are as follows:

- chemical requirements in [Clause 6](#);
- product information requirements in [9.1](#) and [9.4](#).

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
