This draft amendment prAA, if approved, will modify the European Standard FprEN IEC 62841-4-11:2026; it is submitted to CENELEC members for enquiry.
Deadline for CENELEC: 2026-07-03.

It has been drawn up by CLC/TC 116.

If this draft becomes an amendment, CENELEC members are bound to comply with the CEN/CENELEC Internal Regulations which stipulate the conditions for giving this amendment the status of a national standard without any alteration.

This draft amendment was established by CENELEC in three official versions (English, French, German).

A version in any other language made by translation under the responsibility of a CENELEC member into its own language and notified to the CEN-CENELEC Management Centre has the same status as the official versions.

15 This document (FprEN IEC 62841-4-11:2026/prAA:2026) has been prepared by CLC/TC 116 “Safety and
16 environmental aspects of motor-operated electric tools”.

17 This document is currently submitted to the Enquiry.

18 The following dates are proposed:

- latest date by which the existence of this document has to be announced at national level (doa) dav + 6 months
- latest date by which this document has to be implemented at national level by publication of an identical national standard or by endorsement (dop) dav + 12 months
- latest date by which the national standards conflicting with this document have to be withdrawn (dow) dav + 48 months (to be confirmed or modified when voting)

19 This document is read in conjunction with EN 62841-1:2015 (Part 1) and all its amendments and corrigenda (if
20 any).

21 This document supplements or modifies the corresponding clauses in EN 62841-1:2015 and all of its
22 amendments and corrigenda (if any), so as to convert it into the European Standard: Particular requirements
23 for **edgers**.

24 Where a particular subclause of Part 1 is not mentioned in this document, that subclause applies as far as
25 relevant. When this document states “addition”, “modification” or “replacement”, the relevant text in Part 1 is to
26 be adapted accordingly.

27 Clauses, subclauses, notes, tables, figures and annexes which are additional to those in IEC 62841-4-11:2026
28 are prefixed “Z”.

29 This document follows the overall requirements of EN ISO 12100:2010.

30 This document has been prepared under a standardization request addressed to CENELEC by the European
31 Commission. The Standing Committee of the EFTA States subsequently approves these requests for its
32 Member States.
