This document (prEN 1914:2026) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 15 “Inland navigation vessels”, the secretariat of which is held by DIN.

This document is currently submitted to the CEN Enquiry.

This document will supersede EN 1914:2016.

prEN 1914:2026 includes the following significant technical changes with respect to EN 1914:2016:

- a) requirements and references regarding fire protection in 6 Materials changed and updated;
- b) Normative references and bibliography updated;
- c) Editorial changes.

This document was written up for ship's boats, for inland navigation vessels and maritime construction company work boats.

This document specifies requirements for ship's boats covered in Article 13.07 of European Standard laying down Technical Requirements for Inland Navigation vessels (ES-TRIN). The latter is mandatory for inland navigation vessels in accordance with Directive (EU) 2016/1629 and the Rhine Vessel Inspection Regulations.

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1 Scope

This document applies to:

- ship's boats that can be carried on inland navigation vessels according to ES-TRIN;
- lifeboats if no special life-saving equipment (e.g. ADN¹) is specified for the area of use;
- work boats for the transport of a limited number of persons or smaller working loads in the construction site area and over comparatively short distances.

This document does not apply to:

- recreational craft according to Directive 2013/53/EU;
- firefighting and water rescue boats.

boat for the transportation of persons and working loads and for operational working tasks in construction site areas

ship's boat

boat carried on an inland navigation vessel
