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The aim of this document is to provide a method to assess the changes in appearance of textile product, after domestic washing and drying, and to provide a check-list of potential changes in appearance. Within this perspective, the textile product evaluation is based on the use of existing "tools" (such as replicas, photographs, grading schemes) described in other standards. In any cases, the use of such tools does not imply that their original standard is superseded by the method of this document. The individual standards are not replaced by this document. In case of significant discrepancies between results from the application of the method of this document and a concerned standard, this concerned standard remains the reference.

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
