This document (EN 16647-1:2025) has been prepared by Technical Committee CEN/TC 46 “Fireplaces for liquid fuels”, the secretariat of which is held by DIN.

This European Standard shall be given the status of a national standard, either by publication of an identical text or by endorsement, at the latest by June 2026, and conflicting national standards shall be withdrawn at the latest by June 2026.

Attention is drawn to the possibility that some of the elements of this document may be the subject of patent rights. CEN shall not be held responsible for identifying any or all such patent rights.

This document supersedes EN 16647:2015.

EN 16647-1:2025 includes the following significant technical changes with respect to EN 16647:2015:

- alignment with Mandate M/538 and Commission Decision (EU) 2015/547 throughout the whole text;
- change of Scope and splitting the document into two parts; this part covers manually operated fireplaces;
- removal of all requirements regarding automatically operated fireplaces (e.g. Annex B); these will be covered in Part 2;
- removal of gelatinous fuel;
- restructure of Clause 5;
- addition of requirements for glass screens in 4.8.2;
- revision of the entire combustion subclause 5.3.6;
- revision of Clause 9 (Factory production control).

This document has been prepared under a standardization request addressed to CEN by the European Commission. The Standing Committee of the EFTA States subsequently approves these requests for its Member States.
